





The list of items needed is in the bulletin each Sunday. The time to start donation is now, prior to the start of Foster Family Respite event, which begins November 3. Volunteers are always needed and, in this instance, will require a fingerprint scan and /or background check. Please talk with Pastor Sarah and Carol Steffieri about volunteering for this ministry. However, there are so many ways to contribute and the program is open ended at this time. It is our prayer to be able to provide this "Grace Time" for children in foster care and their foster parents. The initial event will be Saturday, November 3. We will host a group of 25 children at GLC for play, crafts, snacks and lunch while their parents attend mandatory classes. As a monthly calendar event, we will experience hosting different age groups and groups with physical challenges. It's simple to see where the NEEDS come into the picture. Previously, he earned the Master of Sacred Music degree at the University of Notre Dame, where he studied organ with Craig Cramer, and the Bachelor of Arts in Sacred Music at Lenoir-Rhyne University, where he studied organ with Florence Jowers and conducting with Paul Weber. Brandon has spent the last two years as the Interim Organist and Director of Youth and Children's Bells at Pinnacle Presbyterian Church in Scottsdale. While at Notre Dame, he was an organist at the Basilica of the Sacred Heart on campus in addition to working with the various choral ensembles at the basilica. While at Lenoir-Rhyne, a small ELCA college in his native North Carolina, he was the music director at St. Paul Lutheran Church where he directed the adult and children's choirs and the handbell ensemble in addition to serving as organist. Brandon has also trained in organ building with both the Noack Organ Company of Georgetown, MA, and Taylor and Boody Organbuilders of Staunton, VA. Recently, Brandon performed

on the Piccolo Spoleto L'Organo Series in Charleston, SC, and accompanied the Phoenix Symphony Chorus on their performance of Duruflé's Requiem.

PARTNERSHIP SPOTLIGHT

Partnership with Lord of Life Lutheran Church, Sun City West

Grace has partnered with Lord of Life Lutheran Church in Sun City West since at least 2000. After Grace had been hosting the community pancake breakfast for some time, Grace received questions on Sunday mornings and during the week about the availability of certain resources such as blankets, hygiene supplies, and backpacks from pancake breakfast guests. At the same time, members of the congregation and other congregations who partnered with Grace on the pancake breakfast would ask: Could someone use (whatever the person had to give)? The idea of the Grace Room was born, and Lord of Life Lutheran Church in Sun City West was the primary partner in starting it. For the last 18 years, alongside Grace volunteers, Lord of Life volunteers have sought out, sorted, and distributed donations to the community. In addition, we receive food donations on a regular basis that we use for GLOW. Lord of Life has gifted us with our commercial stoves, our commercial freezer, and our ice machine. Each summer, Lord of Life typically provides sack lunches for two entire weeks of heat respite, totaling approximately 2,000 sack lunches (200 per day). Members of Lord of Life have participated in our outreach team meetings and regularly give monetary donations toward our outreach ministry. We give thanks to God for Lord of Life's steadfast partnership, for their generous gifts, and for their loving spirits!

Tithe.ly: A New Online Giving Option

The ELCA has reached a preferred vendor agreement with Tithe.ly, a company that offers online tools to enhance financial giving to ELCA congregation and ministries. Through Tithe.ly, donation forms are integrated into the congregation's website instead of sending donors to third-party sites. Donors have the option to make one-time or recurring gifts to provide more consistent giving.

Here at Grace, we are participating in Tithe.ly to reduce the cost of online giving. To sign up, go to www.graceinthecity.com/donate. On the donations page of our website, you click on either one of the "give" buttons and then fill out the online form with either your credit card or bank account information.

This program is similar to PayPal but less expensive and used only by churches. Thank you for giving to Grace!
